Notes from the December 9th Meeting

- The December 9th call focused on the rising number of COVID-19 cases spreading across the US and how the PFDI members are dealing with it. And also, the new vaccines and how this will affect funeral directors as essential workers. Fred Dickey shared with the group a letter from the Texas Funeral Directors Association, who has been working with the State of Texas, that states that death care workers are included in the Phase 1A Healthcare Worker definition for the COVID vaccine distribution. He suggested that members should contact their state health departments for information.
- Mike Leavitt, who also shared with everyone the PPP information and deadlines to get your funding, said he would look into the vaccination process. He reported back to Marilyn and Erica with information from ICCFA. ICCFA has provided a letter you can take to your health department stating that you are an essential worker.
